#### BOARD OF EXAMINATIONS FOR SEAFARERS TRUST (BES)

Report on activities of BES Trust for Financial Year 2020-21

General Purpose Rating (GP) & Certificate for Marine Catering Examinations (CCMC):

Board of Examinations for Seafarers Trust has been conducting Exit Examinations for GP and CCMC Ratings since 2006. Presently, there are a total of 48 institutes all over India. During the year, BES was required to conduct the exit examination in the month of June 2020 for the ratings who had taken admission in these institutes in the month of January 2020. But, due to the pandemic, the institutes were asked by DGS to close down in the month of March 2020. Hence, BES could not hold the exit examination scheduled in June 2020. DGS had to also, cancel admission of July to December 2020 batch of candidates who were supposed to get enrolled into the courses in the month of July 2020 in light of GS ordered opening up the training for the ratings of the pre-sea institutes in the month of November 2020 in phased manner allowing only 1/3rd of batch strength in the campus at any time. The training institutes divided their batches and resumed training. BES carried out the exit examination for the ratings as they completed their training in an institute. There are a total of 102 divided batches of candidates who are required to be examined. BES held the exit examination for 96 divided batches of 42 institutes as on 28th February 2021. BES proposed to DGS for declaration of results in two phases as the completion of examinations was taking long time for the entire batch strength of an institute. BES prepared the 1st phase results for the candidates of 42 institutes that had completed the examination and submitted the same to DGS for declaration on 22.03.2021. DGS published the results on their Website on 31.03.2021. BES continued holding the exit examination of 4 more institutes in March 2021 when they reported their readiness.

March 2020 repeaters' examination was also held along with the fresh candidates. Their results were also prepared and submitted to DGS on 22.03.2021 along with the phase 1 results of fresh candidates. During the year of 2020-21, one exit examination was only held partly for the fresh candidates and one fully for the repeater candidates due to Covid-19.
